



Spring Break Rules

Sea Shell is a family-friendly complex – quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.

An adult aged 25 or older MUST reside in each unit and be present overnight every night of the booking. No splitting of parties to place guests under age 25 and adults over age 25 in separate units.

No more than 6 overnight occupants per unit.

Do not throw items from balconies. It is extremely dangerous and can lead to injury or death. Do not pour liquids from the balconies.

Do not knock on the doors of other guests unless they are known to you. No games of “knock and run.”

No large parties at any time on or in any area of the complex, including the private beach area.

The Tiki Hut’s maximum occupancy is 24 persons.

Only registered guests may sign up to use the grills – sign-up sheets are in the office.

Only registered guests are allowed in the pool. Bathing load is 19 persons. Total pool area occupancy is limited to 30 persons.

No roughhousing in the pool area, including jumping in the pool, throwing chairs in the pool, pushing other bathers into the pool, etc.

All vehicles must display a valid parking permit. Violators will be towed. Additional parking outside of assigned spaces is available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Beach chairs are reserved for registered Sea Shell guests only.

Do not give out the beach or gate code to anyone you don’t know.

No towels, bathing suits, or drinks on the balcony railings/walls.

A security service patrols the beach area and complex during high season to help ensure compliance with these rules.
